**1893: Gandhi's first act of civil disobedience** - As a young Indian lawyer working in South Africa, Mohandas Gandhi, is thrown out of a train at the Pietermaritzburg railway station for refusing to move to a third class compartment since he held a valid first class ticket. This incident prompted him to fight against racial oppression using non-violent methods.
