to find out their family history. You will learn how to detect and avoid the massive number of mistakes made in public records and genealogy fee-based services.

The lab will be monitored by a veteran family history researcher, and it will be offered at a time so that working people can attend. A laptop with wifi capability will be necessary. (Windows based laptops will work better with the free applications) The first session of the lab will be a review of practical family history research and how to avoid common mistake and errors, and will also include a “hands on” training on the genealogical research tools provided with the lab. Researchers should attend the informational introductory lab session and then attend as they can.

For additional details, email Jim Dedman at jdedman3@yahoo.com and put “Genealogy Lab” in the subject line of the email. You will receive a detailed informational reply about the lab. He will address questions you may have.

The goal of the lab is to prepare you to research your family story on your own using free tools and techniques and how to record your stories in an orderly fashion for review. You need not attend every session, but the first few sessions where the resources are explained and effective research is discussed are important. Space in the Parish Hall is somewhat limited, so make your considerations early.
